



General overview of application procedure of basic substances

The criteria for approval of basic substances is laid down in Article 23 of Regulation (EC) No 1107/2009. Further guidance of the procedure is given in the Commission Working document SANCO/10363/2012 rev. 10.

Pre-submission phase

Potential applicant requests general pre-submission advice (optional)

Potential applicant notifies studies commissioned or carried out as of 27 March 2021

Submission and validation phase

Applicant submits IUCLID dossier

EC performs validity check, confirms acceptance and registers in EU Pesticides Database

EFSA publishes non-confidential IUCLID dossier

EFSA launches public consultation

MS or any other interested party have possibility to propose additional uses

EFSA launches MS consultation followed by EFSA commenting

Applicant responds to comments and submits updated IUCLID dossier

EC sends specific mandate to EFSA

EFSA prepares Technical Report

Confidentiality decision-making and proactive disclosure

Consultation and assessment phase

EFSA organises complete or focussed peer review, and delivers conclusion on certain specific open points, if requested by EC (optional)

EC prepares Review Report and draft Regulation

Post-approval and decision-making phase

Standing Committee on Plants, Animals, Food and Feed opinion
