



Application procedure for food additives, flavouring and food enzymes

The application procedure for food additives, food enzymes and flavourings is set down in Regulation EC 1331/2008. Further administrative and technical requirements for applications are explained in Commission Regulation EU 234/2011. Applications should be submitted to the European Commission (EC), which has provided a practical guidance for applicants containing a check list and useful addresses, contact points and relevant documents. EFSA has published scientific guidance documents detailing the requirements for preparing the applications.

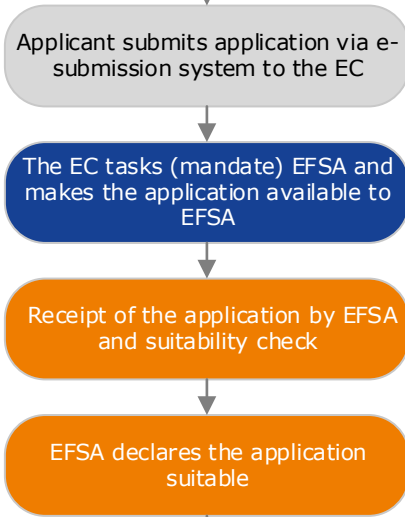

Pre-submission phase



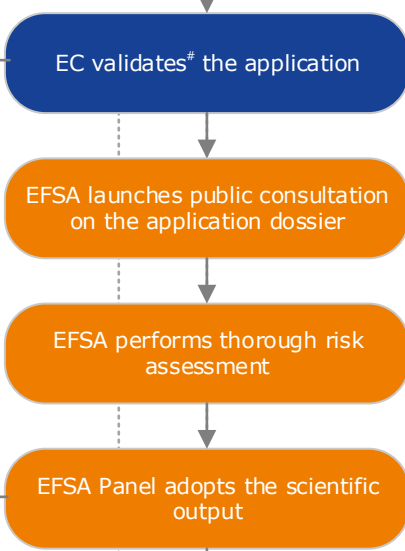
Regulation EC 1331/2008

30 working days (legal deadline)*

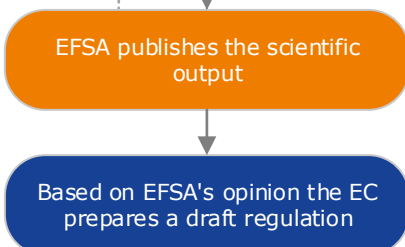
Risk assessment phase
